- 3. **Submit for permit**: Upon verbal verification from the office of Planning, Development & Sustainability and Missoula Public Health you can move forward with submitting your permit applications. Example plans:

- **Framed Garages:** Conventional framed one and two car garage/storage/workshops for a simple yet spacious option to store vehicles as well as other garden equipment, tools, etc.
- **Pole Barns:** Compared to traditional buildings, pole structures tend to be more affordable and can be used to house farm animals, feed, farm equipment or vehicles or provide extra storage space.
- **Shipping Container Storage:** A spacious but not fully enclosed option that provides significant storage space for larger items but not fully enclosed.
- Customizable features: Depending on your needs, some designs offer basic adjustments like door placement or window additions, as well as cost-saving foundation plans. Keep in mind there is only so much you can do to these pre-engineered structures and some customizations may require an Engineer of Record to review.
